

In week 2 the bantam Blue Knights hosted the Cumberland Grey Panthers. In a drizzly, rainy game the Knights were still able to hang onto the ball in a strong passing game. Caleigh Southgate kept the Panthers QB contained with great rushing to give the Knights a 13 – 7 victory.
